

Top 35 Fastest Online College Programs





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Today's world is a high-tech one and everyone seems to want things now, or at the very least fast, and higher education is no exception.

Nobody wants to (nor should) sacrifice quality over speed when it comes to the best degrees to get online, and the colleges and programs on this list have been chosen for this reason. The fastest <u>online college</u> programs are not always easy to define, and sometimes it all depends on the student and their prior knowledge, experience, or previously earned credits.

Quality is more easily measured through school statistics taken from schools which offer students fast online degrees. Below you will find 35 of the best online colleges which offer accelerated degree programs.

Methodology

In order to find the best institutions of higher learning which offer students the fastest online programs, first the schools which offer accelerated programs were compiled to a list. Next, data was gathered using resources such as:

- National Center for Education Statistics (NCES)
- COLLEGEdata
- Niche

The data from NCES and COLLEGEdata consisted of the cost of attendance to the school, which can be an important factor for many students. Also, from these sources, the overall graduation rate was collected. All students are different and the personal drive will have a great influence on pursuing a program to end. However, institutions with a higher graduation rate may have an advantage when it comes to keeping students interested and motivated, therefore it was a factor taken into account.

Niche data is provided several ways, most schools have an overall score which was taken and converted into a numeric scale whereas A+ = 100, A = 90, and so on in that matter. In rare cases where the information was only presented in a 5-star format, 5 stars are converted to an A and then to the numeric scale whereas it would become a 90, 4 stars would be considered a B and then converted to a number, and so forth. Niche also provides an academic score which was used in the same fashion. When an academic score was not present, a professor score was used in place of it. If neither were available, the review stars were used in place once again, as most reviews are of the academic aspect of the school. It is rare that the star system is used in order to complete data collection in either case.

In order to assign a numerical score to the institutions, percentages for graduation were converted to plain numbers. For example, a 46% graduation rate would be counted as 46. The cost of attendance was rounded up or down to the nearest thousand, so a school which cost \$42,395 to attend would be counted as a 42. The overall and academic/professor scores from Niche were then added to graduation rate. As a lower cost of attendance is more desirable, that number was then subtracted from the sum for a ranking score.

The formula:

Graduation Rate + Overall Niche Score + Academic or Professor Niche Score – Rounded Cost

= Ranking Score

We also referenced the Top 100 Best Online Colleges ranking during our research.

35. Becker College

Becker College is located in Worcester, Massachusetts and also has a campus in Leicester. There are a number of online courses offered through the Center for Accelerated & Professional Studies at Becker College as well as accelerated courses offered over intersession each winter. The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) program is offered online for the convenience of adult learners. Also, there are opportunities to earn college credit for prior experience through Portfolio, which is a class for the assessment of non-classroom learning. Students with qualified experiences can earn up to 48 credits through participating in the portfolio process. In addition, students may qualify for employer tuition reimbursement programs depending upon their current employment status.



34. Notre Dame College

Notre Dame College is located in Cleveland, Ohio and offers students a variety of online programs. The online courses at Notre Dame College are delivered in an accelerated format and most last for 8 weeks. Students are expected to spend 8 to 10 hours per week on a course which offers 3 credits. Learning activities are comprised of both online and offline activities and online terms do not have holiday breaks. Undergraduate degrees offered online are Associate of Arts in Business Administration, Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration (Management), Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, Bachelor of Arts in Education, RN to BSN, and Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice. Graduate degrees available online through Notre Dame College are Master of Education, MSN, and Master of Arts in National Security and Intelligence Studies. Masters degrees are often regarded as the best degrees to get online, as they can be completed while maintaining employment.

33. Mercy College



Mercy College is located in Dobbs Ferry, New York and offers students a fast track to earning their bachelor's degree in the field of Organizational Management. Mercy College offers this program for qualified students who have already earned their associate's degree or 60 undergraduate credits. Students who meet the requirements are able to obtain their bachelor's degree in as few as 12 months. Online students will participate and meet their course requirements in a flexible time frame. While it is a three-semester schedule, students progress through one three-credit course per month.

32. Colorado Technical University

Colorado Technical University in Colorado Springs offers online students a fast track option to accelerate obtaining their degree. With this option, students can not only save time but money on courses and materials as well. Participating in Fast Track does not have an additional cost and students are able to take up to two Fast Track exams a week in order to gain credit for courses. There is no penalty for not passing, which would be below 70%, the course remains on the student's schedule. Students are only permitted to take the exam once per course but are able to take multiple course exams.

31. Western Governors University

Founded by 19 U.S. Governors and based in Salt Lake City, Utah, Western Governors University is focused on providing the best online programs which also save students time and money. Most bachelor degrees take students only three years to earn through WGU. Due to competency-based programs, students work with a Faculty Mentor in order to optimize their schedule and move quickly through material they already know and take the time they need to learn the material they don't already know. Of course, students who have already earned college credits may be eligible to transfer those credits in order to further accelerate through their chosen program.

Classes are designed for adult learners and are offered in 8-week terms with 6 terms per year. Two courses are able to be taken per year which means a student may be able to earn up to 36 credit hours each year. Students have a choice of several popular areas of study such as Business Administration, Psychology, and Computer Science. There are several ways students are able to complete their programs quickly at Florida State College at Jacksonville, which include +1 Planning where students add one course each semester and attend year round to earn their degree sooner, Prior Learning Assessment (PLA), and Accelerated Curriculums designed to streamline obtaining a degree. Some examples of the online degree programs which are accelerated are a bachelor's degree in Business Administration, an Associate in Arts degree, and a Real Estate Agent Workforce Certificate.

Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees are available in General Studies, bachelors degrees offered are in Business Administration, Cyber Security, Health Care Administration, Health Information Management, Psychology, and General Studies, each with different electives and/or concentrations to choose from. week or 8-week durations. Online students are able to progress quickly through the material in this manner. There are hundreds of degree programs for online students to choose from including bachelor's, master's, as well as doctoral. Areas of study offered online through GCU are Business & Management; Criminal, Political & Social Sciences; Engineering & Technology; Medical Studies & Athletic Sciences; Nursing & Health Care; Performing Arts & Creative Design; Psychology & Counseling; Theology & Ministry; Teaching & School Administration; and Language & Communications.

Students are able to transfer any previously earned credits and continue on toward getting their degree in either Information Technology, Business Administration, or Applied Psychology. Adult degree completion programs are able to be completed in evenings or online. Applied Psychology is an evening class program with two hybrid courses. The Business Administration program offered at Elmhurst is completed in a hybrid format. Information Technology degrees are in an EC Flex model format which allows a student to choose online or classroom.

Courses are delivered in 6-week and 8-week format, depending on the term with 6 starting dates throughout the year. Today, they offer students online options for a large number of associate, bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. Programs are offered in an 8-week format and are often able to be completed faster than earning a traditional degree. Students may be able to further accelerate their progress by transferring previously earned credits or obtaining credit for real-world experience or professional training. Areas of study for degrees include, but are not limited to Business, Education, Criminal Justice, Communications, General Studies, Government, Healthcare, Information Systems, Information Technology, Psychology, Religion, Nursing, Social Work, and Paralegal.

3. University of Wisconsin

The University of Wisconsin system is based in Madison, Wisconsin and has campuses across the state as well as online. Individual courses are offered online in an accelerated format through University of Wisconsin Colleges Online. Courses are condensed into 3, 7, 8, 10 or 12-week terms rather than the traditional 16-week courses. It is recommended that students take no more than 2 accelerated courses at a time or only 1 when paired with a traditional course. The University of Wisconsin also offers a competency-based learning system which are Flexible Options which are mostly online, although the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration is currently the only one available fully online through UW-Extension and is a degree completion program. Other Flex options include an Associate of Arts and Science offered through UW Colleges, RN to BSN completion program, BS in Biomedical Sciences Diagnostic Imaging degree completion program, and a BS in Information Science and Technology degree completion program offered through UW-Milwaukee.

2. Arizona State University

Located in Tempe, Arizona and with origins older than the state itself is Arizona State University. ASU offers students one of the largest selections of online degree programs, with more than 140 programs for both graduates and undergraduates. Online courses are 7.5 weeks which offer students multiple starting dates over the course of a year. ASU also offers a <u>4+1 Accelerated Degree Program</u> which allows qualified students to earn their bachelor's degree and then only take 1 year to earn their master's afterward.

1. Northeastern University

Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts has a strong reputation for its academic quality, and with good reason. Students reporting on Niche give the school an A+ overall as well as academically and the overall graduation rate is 84%, and that number doesn't include students who transfer elsewhere. While Northeastern does offer accelerated bachelor's in Finance and Accounting Management, Health Management, Information Technology, Leadership, and Management, it does still utilize semesters. There are also fast-track accelerated versions of bachelor's degrees for Health Management, Information Technology, Management, and Leadership which requires that a student to have earned an associate's degree or the equivalent number of credits toward a degree.


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
